Funded Training Programs are general posted to the training system 60-90 days prior to the start date of the course. The program comes off the website when it has reached its maximum enrollment or is within ten days from the start date.

VDFP coordinates and delivers fire emergency services education and training programs for the fire and emergency response community, public, law enforcement and industry for the purpose of protecting and defending the commonwealth against the loss of life and property. 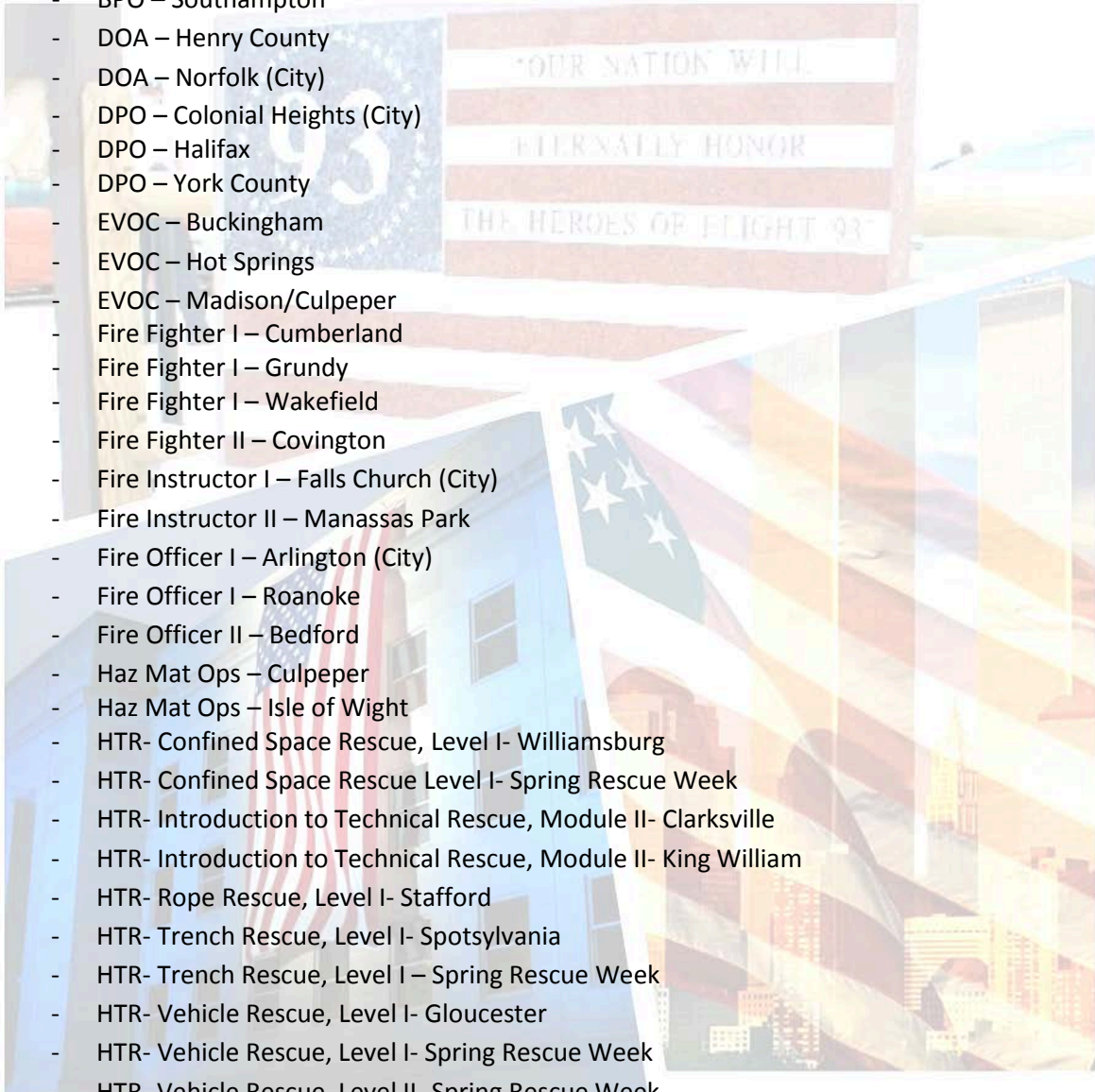

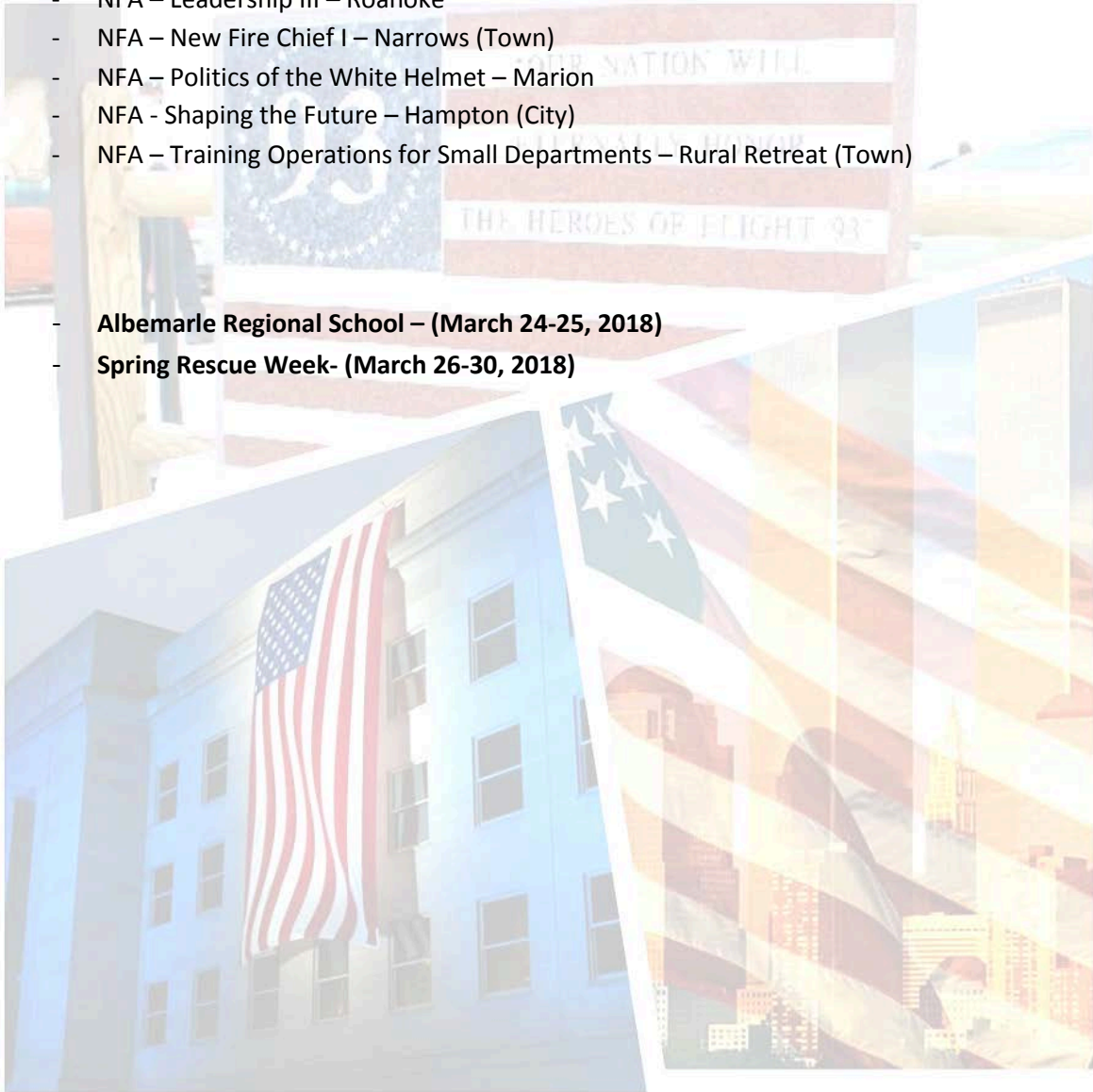


