STUDENT WILL BE ABLE TO IDENTIFY THE COMPONENTS OF FIRE DEPARTMENT OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH PROGRAM; EXPLAIN THE PRINCIPLES OF RISK MANAGEMENT FOR THE FIRE SERVICE; EXPLAIN HOW THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OFFICER MANAGES RISK; DESCRIBE THE COMPONENTS OF A HEALTH MAINTENANCE PROGRAM; DESCRIBE FIREFIGHTER SAFETY CONCERNS RELATING TO CURRENT ISSUES IN THE FIRE SERVICE; AND IDENTIFY CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS.
