REPORT FROM THE VDFP CHIEF OF TRAINING

Chief Jamey Brads spoke on his written report to the committee. The Branch realignment continues as staff become acclimated with the new changes. A new phone tree and inbox system is being put into place to improve customer service. He spoke on various partnerships with other agencies that included enhancing trench safety and technical rescue courses. New equipment has been purchased to help move assets around Virginia. Over 11,000 firefighters have finished the electric vehicle fire training. Various online testing courses are also being piloted via agency owned devices or locality owned equipment.

Chair Rodzinka mentioned he was looking forward to working with the agency and thinks training is moving in a positive direction.

NEW BUSINESS

James Calvert asked about Incident Command System (ICS) 300 and 400 updates. Brads provided that some instructors may go through a bridge program for updates on the new versions of the course. Brads will provide an update and stated that, ideally, it should take about a day to complete.

Calvert asked about rescheduling the National Fire Academy State Weekend. Brads stated the agency was working with the other states (Delaware and Connecticut) and they believe the rescheduled date would be in October. The agency will return to the regular schedule in March for 2026.
