The Virginia Department of Fire Programs is accepting applications for scholarships to attend the VATF-2 24th Annual DHS FEMA Equivalent Structural Collapse Specialist Course.

Applicants must be a member in good standing with a Local, Regional or Divisional Technical Rescue Team. The applicant must have Operations/Level 1 certification at a minimum in all core VDFP technical rescue courses (Rope, Confined Space, Trench and Vehicle), however, applicants with Technician/Level 2 will be given priority during selection.

A letter of recommendation is required from the applicant's department head or team leader, provided on departmental letterhead.

Please submit application and letter of recommendation to Chad Riddleberger. Candidates must also submit a separate VATF-2 application for the course in order to be considered for the scholarship.

Tuition reimbursement is only payable to a jurisdiction, not the individual attending.

Scholarship includes course tuition (valued at \$1,850) and a daily lunch. Transportation, lodging, and additional meals are not covered.

- 3. Above certifications must have been held for at least 2 years.
- 4. EMT-B or above preferred
- 5. Affiliation with a local, regional, State or Federal Technical Rescue or USAR team.
