The Virginia Department of Fire Programs is accepting applications for scholarships to attend the VATF-2 24th Annual DHS FEMA Equivalent Structural Collapse Specialist Course.

Applicants must be a member in good standing with a Local, Regional or Divisional Technical Rescue Team. The applicant must have Operations/Level 1 certification at a minimum in all core VDFP technical rescue courses (Rope, Confined Space, Trench and Vehicle), however, applicants with Technician/Level 2 will be given priority during selection.

A letter of recommendation is required from the applicant's department head or team leader, provided on departmental letterhead.

Please submit application and letter of recommendation to Chad Riddleberger.

**Candidates must also submit a separate VATF-2 application** for the course in order to be considered for the scholarship.

Tuition reimbursement is only payable to a jurisdiction, not the individual attending.

Scholarship includes course tuition (valued at \$1,850) and a daily lunch. Transportation, lodging, and additional meals are not covered.

5. Affiliation with a local, regional, State or Federal Technical Rescue or USAR team.
